1. Reference to Other Regulations

- 1.1. This is LaMSF Category A competition that takes place according to "CROSS COUNTRY REGULATIONS 2020 of Baltic Cup and Baltic Club Team Cup and Latvian Cup and Latvian Club Team Cup", that is available at www.lamsf.lv/sporta-veidi/enduro-cross-country/dokumenti (further CC Regulations), LaMSF Sporting Code and LaMSF Ethics Code.
- 1.2. These Regulations incorporate selected clauses from the CC Regulations and supplement the CC Regulations with specific information about the competition. Changes to these Regulations can be accepted by LaMSF Enduro commission or, on the competition day, by competition jury.
- 1.3. Immaterial deviations from the course description, competition agenda or other specific competition matters included in these Regulations, caused by objective circumstances, shall not be considered as changes to these Regulations, but the Organiser is responsible for timely and clear announcement of such deviations to all competition participants.
- 1.4. Organiser is responsible for the compliance of competition site and organisation with regulations regarding physical distancing to reduce spread of COVID-19. All persons on competition site, including spectators, are personally responsible for complying with these regulations and the instructions of Organiser. Specific requirements:
 - 1.4.1. A competition participant must obey the following requirements if he (she) has arrived from a country, after visiting which self-isolation is mandatory:
 - 1.4.1.1. Rider has to apply for competition registration no later than five working days before the competition, i.e. by Sunday, 25 October.
 - 1.4.1.2. When arriving in Latvia, the rider must possess a negative COVID-19 test result that has been obtained no earlier than 72h before arrival in Latvia. The result of this test must be sent to the organiser by email to dbluma@inbox.lv (call for additional information +371 29121250).
 - 1.4.1.3. On the day of the arrival in Latvia, the rider must undertake the second COVID-19 test. Until a negative test result is received, self-isolation must be observed. Result of this test must be presented when entering the competition territory.

1.4.2. Only one person – mechanic – may accompany a rider on competition site.

1.4.3. The competition will take place without spectators.

3. Competition Classes

Participation in any class is only from full 18 years of age (i.e. counting from the date of birth).

Quads ATV under 750 cm3	Standard quads with 100 cm³ to 750 cm³ 2-stroke or 4-stroke engines, having 1 or 2 cylinders and front and rear wheel drive. Competition scoring and awarding is in addition to scoring and awarding of Quads ATV class (participants in this class are also in Quads ATV class). Results of this competition will not be taken into account in season's rating.

4. Starting Numbers

4.1. Starting numbers must be displayed clearly on both sides and front of a motorcycle:

- 4.2. Starting numbers must be with a minimal height of 10 cm.
- 4.3. Quads must be equipped with front and rear number plates, fastened to the front and rear of the frame.
- 4.4. Numbers on riders' back (except Absolute beginners) must be clearly legible, displayed with a light colour on a dark background, or a dark colour on a light background. Riders with inappropriate numbers on riders' back (e.g. insulating tape) may not be allowed to race.

7. Competition Participants and Registration

- 7.1. Rider's age is calculated according to the year of birth (except the requirement for participation in any class to be only from 18 years of age (i.e. counting from the date of birth)).
- 7.2. Riders must be licensed and insured according to LaMSF rules.
- 7.3. Registration of riders can be performed by a representative of the riders' club or team upon presenting the riders' licenses and other required documents.
- 7.4. Riders may purchase a one-event LaMSF license on competition site, according to LaMSF regulations by presenting or purchasing an appropriate accident insurance policy and presenting an identification document.
- 7.5. Rider with his signature on the application form acknowledges his familiarity with the CC Regulations and these Regulations, his commitment to comply with these regulations, and certifies that he will not hold the competition organiser liable for the accidents caused, among others, by his state of health.
- 7.6. In case the secretariat of the competition or LaMSF Enduro commission discovers that information provided by a rider is incorrect and the rider or his machine does not correspond to the class defined by the regulations, the rider's result can be cancelled without warning during the competition or at any time prior to approval of the season's classifications.
- 7.7. The documents of a rider who has not reached 18 years of age (counting from the date of birth) are signed by one of his parents, a guardian or their notary-authorised representative. In case of purchasing a one-event licence, a document must be presented confirming the consent of parents or the guardian.

8. Early Application

- 8.1. For early application for the competition, the rider must electronically apply on www.enduromanager.eu by 14:00 on 30th October. In case of any problems please send an email to dbluma@inbox.lv
- 8.2. Early registration speeds up the registration of the rider on the competition day.

9. Financial Terms

Participation fee for Absolute Beginners is 30 EUR.

- 9.2. The price of a one-event LaMSF license is according to LaMSF regulations (lamsf.lv/sporta-veidi/enduro/pamatdokumenti).
- 9.3. These payments must be made in cash, to the competition secretariat, on competition day.

10. Competition Track, Security and Environmental Protection

- 10.1. Rider must deliver the machine, helmet and shirt with the starting number to the technical inspection that is located next to the paddock by the time defined in clause 11.1.
- 10.2. Rider or mechanic must present the machine in technical order. Rider is responsible for the technical condition of his machine during the entire competition.
- 10.3. Riders are advised to use neck protector during the competition.
- 10.4. During the competition, the person accompanying the rider must be warned about safety measures during the race, the spectators must not be on the course and within course safety areas, and within start/finish zone.
- 10.5. It is forbidden to smoke in the prestart zone, start/finish zone, pit stop and technical inspection zone.
- 10.6. Refuelling is to be performed only in pit stop after the introductory lap or during the race, and only with the engine stopped.
- 10.7. Passing through the pit stop without stopping and without switching off the engine is forbidden.
- 10.8. During refuelling, oil change, machine repairs or cleaning, a repair mat of an appropriate size and quality must be used.
- 10.9. Due to safety reasons, in case of unforeseen (force majeure) circumstances the course may be shortened or changed, riding times may be shortened, and the sequence of starts may be changed.
- 10.10. In the paddock the maximum allowed speed is 10 km/h.
- 10.11. Use of a helmet is mandatory when riding a machine on the competition site.
- 10.12. Riders before the competition start and after the finish may only ride in the paddock.

In case a relatively large number of competition participants has been registered, the number of riders simultaneously riding on the track will need to be limited. In this situation Head Marshal in coordination with Organiser may decide on other start times, for example:

12. Starting Procedure

- 12.1. After registration and technical inspection of the machine the rider will be allowed to ride 1 (one) lap (introductory lap) during the time period specified in clause 11.1. After the introductory lap, the rider can refuel and repair the machine in the pit stop zone.
- 12.2. Riders are not allowed to ride the introductory lap without prior registration and technical inspection.
- 12.3. After passing the technical inspection or after the introductory lap (and refuelling the machine in the pit stop zone) machines must be placed in prestart zone.
- 12.4. Motorcycles are placed in the pre-start zone as follows:
 - 12.4.1. 1st box: E1, E2/E3, Enduro, Seniors 40+;
 - 12.4.2. 2nd box Hobby, 85 cm³; Juniors 14+, Veterans 50+, Open 1h;
 - 12.4.3. 3rd box Beginners (C) 2T, Beginners (C) 4T, Absolute beginners.
- 12.5. Quads are placed in the pre-start zone as follows:
 - 12.5.1. 1st box: Quads Open
 - 12.5.2. 2nd box: Quads ATV
- 12.6. Riders take starting positions as per consecutive order, guided by officials.
- 12.7. Start signal for all classes is given with engines switched off and with at least 20 seconds interval between start lines.
- 12.8. Start signals:
 - 12.8.1. "2" 2 minutes before start, engines are permitted to run:
 - 12.8.2. "1" 1 minute before start, engines must be switched off;
 - 12.8.3. "15" 15 seconds before start, during which a start shot is made.

13. Outside Assistance and Race Cut

- 13.1. Any outside assistance is prohibited, except in pit stops, except due to safety reasons or in order to help a rider to pull the machine out of mud, ditch, marsh or another obstacle on the course, and the rider is not able to do it by himself.
- 13.2. No course cuts are allowed. In case a rider happens to leave the course he must return to the course as close as possible to the place he left the course.

14. Scoring

- 14.1. The result of a rider is determined by the finish time and the number of laps he has completed.
- 14.2. The finish time is the time when a rider has crossed the finish line after the finish flag is raised for a particular class, if the rider has finished within the control time. The finish flag is shown after the time mentioned in clause 11.2.
- 14.3. The control time depends on the specifics of the course and is equal to the doubled best lap time of the leading rider in a class.
- 14.4. Race results for the finished riders (i.e. those who have a finish time according to 14.2) are based upon the order of crossing the finish line.
- 14.5. Places obtain and points score only the riders who have completed at least 30% of the laps by the leading rider in the class. If any of those riders does not finish the race, he takes place and scores points after the riders who have finished, according to the number of completed laps. If two riders have not finished and have equal number of

- completed laps, the total time of completing those laps is taken into account in determining the result.
- 14.6. Individual and overall results of each competition are determined according to the table below:

15. Club Team Cup

15.1. Latvian Club Team Cup (LCTC) takes place in parallel to the Latvian Individual Cup, with participation of riders of the following classes:

- 15.2. In LCTC, rider's club membership is defined by the annual FMN Enduro license. Participation in LCTC is only with annual FMN Enduro licences.
- 15.3. A LCTC club team consists of 3 to 4 riders from classes mentioned in clause 15.1.
- 15.4. Scores of riders in each class, calculated according to clause 14.6, are applied with a coefficient as stated in clause 15.1.
- 15.5. The team's riders' best 3 individual results out of 4 possible are used for calculating the team's results in a LCTC competition round. Result of a club team is the sum of individual scores of these riders. A rider can contribute to team points only in the class in which he started in his first Cross Country competition of the season in LCTC.
- 15.6. In case two teams in a competition round score equal points, the winner shall be the team with the highest places. If these are also equal, then with the best individual lap time result. In establishing the winning team, the individual results of the 3 riders mentioned in paragraph 15.5, are to be used.

16. Awarding

- 16.1. Winners of 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in individual (in each class) competition will be awarded with cups, medals or other prizes. The first three places to be awarded. Organiser's cup will be provided to winners of 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in Open 1h, Absolute Beginners and Quads under 750 cm3 classes.
- 16.2. The winner of the 1st place (2-hour race E1, E2/E3 and Enduro classes) of Latvian Cup will be awarded according to the overall score.
- 16.3. Riders to be awarded must participate in the awarding ceremony that takes place not later than two hours after the finish of the last rider. Penalty for not participating in the awarding ceremony is 50 euro that is to be paid by the rider. Penalty is not applied in

case the rider has agreed his absence with competition organiser or Chief Marshal and the awarding ceremony is attended by the rider's club representative.

17. Protests

- 17.1. All protests, addressed to jury, are submitted to the secretariat in written form with a security deposit of 70 euro.
- 17.2. Protests on results must be submitted within 30 minutes after the official announcement of results.
- 17.3. Protests on breach of CC Regulations or these Regulations must be submitted within 10 minutes after the finish of respective class, by indicating the violated clause of CC Regulations or these Regulations.
- 17.4. In case the protest is related to dismantling of engine, additional 70 euro must be paid in deposit for a 2-stroke engine disassembly, and 215 euro for 4-stroke.
