#### 1. Reference to Other Regulations and Changes to Regulations

- 1.1. This is LMSF Category A competition that takes place according to "ENDURO REGULATIONS 2023 of Baltic Open Individual Championship, Baltic Cup, Baltic OpenClub Championship, Lithuanian Enduro Championship and Cup, that is available at www.lmsf.lt (further Enduro Regulations), LMSF Sporting Code and LMSF Ethics Code.
- 1.2. These competition Regulations incorporate selected clauses from the Enduro Regulations and supplement the Enduro Regulations with specific information about thecompetition. Changes to these Regulations can be accepted by LMSF Enduro Commission or, on the competition day, by competition jury.
- 1.3. Immaterial deviations from the course description, competition agenda or other specific competition matters included in these Regulations, caused by objective circumstances, shall not be considered as changes to these Regulations, but the Organiser is responsible for timely and clear announcement of such deviations to all competition participants.

- 11.2. First start on the second day at 9:00 a.m.
- 11.3. Special tests (numbered sequentially on the course)

1. test	Cross test: motocross track combined with a forest track, length ~3km. For all classes.
2. test	Enduro test: forest test with hills, length ~5km. For all classes.

11.4. Driving direction and marking: red signs and the same driving direction on both days.

#### 12. Competition Track, Security and Environmental Protection

- 12.1. No spectators are allowed on course during the competition.
- 12.2. Minimum safety distance in start-finish, time check and special test areas is 1 m.
- 12.3. It is forbidden to smoke in the paddock, on the track, technical inspection area, parcferme, start-finish and time check points.
- 12.4. Spectators and competition participants are personally responsible for their safety.
- 12.5. During refuelling, oil change, machine repairs or cleaning, a repair mat of adequate sizeand

- quality must be used.
- 12.6. Washing of machines is forbidden, except if the organiser permits this in a designated place.
- 12.7. The use of "tear-off" films on goggles is forbidden.
- 12.8. Riders must obey the traffic regulations in force in each locality crossed during the competition. Any rider convicted of an offence against such regulations may, after enquiry, be excluded.
- 12.9. Maximum allowed machine speed in the paddock is 10 km/h.
- 12.10. Helmet must be worn when riding a machine on the competition site.
- 12.11. Before the competition start and after the finish, riders are only allowed to ride in the paddock.

#### 13. Starting Procedure, Parc Ferme

- 13.1. After registration and technical inspection, riders or mechanics put their machines intoparc ferme (PF).
- 13.2. Before the enduro start, riders will be allowed to enter the Parc Ferme 5 minutes before their starting times.
- 13.3. Riders of the Hobby, Beginners (C), Veterans 50+, LT classes do not have to place their machines in PF after the competition on the second day.

#### 14. Outside Assistance, Race Cut

- 14.1. The term "outside assistance" refers to the act involved when any person, other than the rider or an official performing his duties, comes into contact with the machine.
- 14.2. The penalty for receiving prohibited outside assistance is exclusion.
- 14.3. Outside assistance is permitted in order to help a rider to pull the machine out of mud, ditch, marsh or another obstacle on the course, and the rider is not able to do it by himself. Marshals are allowed to provide assistance to riders in tests if the rider is not able to overcome an obstacle or to free the track for other riders.
- 14.4. Outside assistance is allowed at time checks and in other cases described in Enduro Regulations.
- 14.5. Short-cutting the special test track is forbidden. In case a rider leaves the track, he mustreturn to the track as close as possible to the place where he left.

16.1. Club Team Championship according to the Baltic, LMSF, LaMSF and EMF regulation

#### 17. Awarding

- 17.1. The winners of the top 3 places in each class will be awarded with cups, medals or other prizes.
- 17.2. Riders to be awarded must participate in the awarding ceremony. Penalty for not participating in the awarding ceremony is 50 euro that is to be paid by the rider. Penalty is not applied in case the rider has agreed his absence with competition organiser or Chief Marshal and the awarding ceremony is attended by the rider's club representative.

#### 18. Protests

- 18.1. All protests are submitted to the secretariat in written form with a security deposit of 70 euro.
- 18.2. Protests on results must be submitted within 30 minutes after the official announcement of results.
- 18.3. Protests on breach of the competition Regulations or the Enduro Regulations must be submitted within 30 minutes after the finish of respective class, by indicating the violated clause of competition Regulations or Enduro Regulations.
